

The W. H. And H. W. Harris Bursary

(Originally established as the W.H. and H.W. Harris Scholarship in 1969 by a bequest of \$6000 from Mrs Bessie Florence Harris in memory of her late husband William Henry Harris, a former Headmaster of the Manly and East Brisbane State Schools, who served in both World Wars, and their only child Hector William, who was lost on active service in 1947.)

- 1. One Bursary will be awarded annually by Senate.
- 2. The Bursary will be awarded to a female student of the University who obtains the best results in an academic year involving at least #14 and who attended a Queensland secondary school in the previous year.
- 3. Preference will be given to a lineal descendant of a person eligible to be accepted as a member of Australian War Widows Queensland.
- 4. The Bursary will be renewed on the basis of academic performance in the program and will be tenable for a maximum of three years while enrolled in the program.
- 5. The value of the Bursary will be one third of the annual income of the fund.
