# **Conrad Gargett Public Architecture Prize**

(Established in 2007 and maintained by an annual gift from Conrad Gargett Architecture.)

#### (a) Recommending authority

Head of School of Architecture.

### (b) Eligibility

Students who are completing or have completed the Master of Architecture in the year of the award.

### (c) Basis for award

Best application based on -

- an architectural design project completed in the Master of Architecture that best embodies the ideas for architecture and its relationship to the public realm; and
- (ii) a domestic travel proposal that will enable the recipient to gain greater understanding and knowledge of the role of public architecture in the formation of cities and communities.

# (d) Nature of prize

Two prizes will be awarded, with each recipient receiving

- (i) Certificate of award; and
- (ii) \$2,500; and
- (iii) \$1,000 contribution to travel; and
- (iv) \$250 book voucher; and
- (v) 1 year membership to the Australian Institute of Architects (AIA).

# (e) Other provisions

- (i) Applications must be lodged with the Head of School by the date set by the Head.
- (ii) The recipient must present a seminar at The University of Queensland on return from their travel experience to share the knowledge and experience gained.
