



Conrad Gargett Public Architecture Prize

(Established in 2007 and maintained by an annual gift from Conrad Gargett Architecture.)

(a) Recommending authority

Head of School of Architecture.

(b) Eligibility

Students who are completing or have completed the Master of Architecture in the year of the award.

(c) Basis for award

Best application based on –

- (i) an architectural design project completed in the Master of Architecture that best embodies the ideas for architecture and its relationship to the public realm; and
- (ii) a domestic travel proposal that will enable the recipient to gain greater understanding and knowledge of the role of public architecture in the formation of cities and communities.

(d) Nature of prize

Two prizes will be awarded, with each recipient receiving

- (i) Certificate of award; and
- (ii) \$2,500; and
- (iii) \$1,000 contribution to travel; and
- (iv) \$250 book voucher; and
- (v) 1 year membership to the Australian Institute of Architects (AIA).

(e) Other provisions

- (i) Applications must be lodged with the Head of School by the date set by the Head.
- (ii) The recipient must present a seminar at The University of Queensland on return from their travel experience to share the knowledge and experience gained.
