



4MBS Musica Viva Sid Page Memorial Prize in Chamber Music

(The Sid Page Prize was established in 1988 in memory of Sidney B. Page and is maintained from income of a fund established by donations from his family, colleagues and friends. Sidney Page was Deputy Librarian of this University from 1966 to 1972 and Librarian of Griffith University from that time until 1983. He was a member of the Music Faculty Board from 1971 until his death in 1987 and a founding member of the Music Broadcasting Society of Queensland Ltd.)

(a) Recommending authority

Head, School of Music.

(b) Eligibility

Ensembles consisting of up to 8 students of the University.

(c) Basis for award

The ensemble which gives the most outstanding performance in the competition.

(d) Nature of prize

- (i) At least \$3,825 but limited to the distribution of the fund; and
- (ii) a 4MBS broadcast of the winning ensemble's performance, including the Community Radio Network satellite service; and
- (iii) 'Take 3' subscriptions to Musica Viva's Brisbane concert series for up to four members of the winning ensemble.
