



Sum, Wing and Leong Fong Prize in Radiology

(The Sum, Wing and Leong Fong Prize in Radiology was established in 2020. Professor Kwun Fong, along with the Fong and Franz families, wishes to honour the memory of UQ alumnus Dr Sum Fong, a radiologist who passed away in 2017. The families also established an endowed prize available to UQ staff. With the creation of this prize the families wish to support academically excellent students who may be interested in pursuing careers in radiology.)

(a) Recommending authority

The prize shall be awarded on recommendation from the Head, Northside Clinical Unit, Greater Brisbane Clinical School, Medical School, after consultation with a selection committee, comprising –

- (i) Head, Northside Clinical Unit, Greater Brisbane Clinical School, Medical School, as chair of the committee;
- (ii) the Director, Academy for Medical Education (or nominee); and
- (iii) the Director of Medical Imaging, The Prince Charles Hospital (or nominee).

(b) Eligibility

The prize is open to students who –

- (i) are enrolled in the Doctor of Medicine Program and have completed a clinical rotation at The Prince Charles Hospital in the year of the award or are holders of a UQ Summer / Winter Research Scholarship; and
- (ii) submit an application to the Head of the UQ Northside Clinical Unit at The Prince Charles Hospital.

(c) Basis for award

Student with the highest scoring radiology-related research presentation at a peer-reviewed Departmental meeting.

(d) Nature of prize

Money to the value of at least \$1,000, but limited to the annual income from the fund
