



## The Sleath String Performance Prize

(Established in 1998 by a bequest by Howard Sleath of 50% of his estate to the University of Queensland. Mr Howard Sleath was well-known to instrumentalists throughout Australia for the excellence of his craftsmanship and skill as a maker of stringed instruments. Mr Sleath gave the State of Queensland a string quartet of instruments to be kept under the supervision of the Head, School of Music. The instruments were first demonstrated by the Mayne String Quartet at a concert to inaugurate the Howard Sleath Quartet of Instruments in 1974.)

**(a) Recommending authority**

Head, School of Music.

**(b) Eligibility**

Students enrolled in the Bachelor of Music or Bachelor of Music (Honours) or a dual program that includes the Bachelor of Music or Bachelor of Music (Honours).

**(c) Basis for award**

Most outstanding performance played on an orchestral stringed instrument with a bow.

**(d) Nature of prize**

Money equal to the annual income from the fund allocated to this Prize.
