French Language Legacy Prize

(Established in 2024 and maintained by an endowment originating from a bequest from Dorothy Marsden, a French Teacher at Ipswich Girls' Grammar School. Significant donations were also received from the family and friends of the late Emily John, former Honours student; from the French Teachers Branch of the Modern Language Teachers Association of Queensland; and further donors who acknowledged family, classmates, students, teachers and colleagues in French or simply donated to support future students.)

(a) Recommending Authority

Head of School, School of Languages and Cultures after consultation with a selection committee, comprising –

- (i) the Head of School, School of Languages and Cultures (or nominee);
- (ii) at least one member of the university's academic staff who is currently teaching in the French discipline; and
- (iii) a member of academic staff from the School of Languages and Cultures.

(b) Eligibility

An applicant is eligible, if the applicant –

- (i) has submitted an application by the closing date as determined by the Head of School, School of Languages and Cultures;
- (ii) is enrolled in a program at The University of Queensland with a declared French/French Advanced major;
- (iii) has completed at least four units in FREN coded courses; and
- (iv) has identified an opportunity to commence within 12 months of the application, which will enhance their studies of French and that will be enabled by this award.

(c) Basis for Award

The prize will be made to encourage the student who is the most outstanding applicant based on -

- (i) academic achievement in FREN coded courses undertaken to date;
- (ii) strength of personal statement outlining personal and leadership qualities, and the value of the proposed experience to the applicant's academic and/or professional development.

(d) Nature of Prize

At least \$1,000 but limited to the annual income from the fund, to be paid upon confirmation of acceptance into the proposed experience.

(e) Other Provisions

- (i) in accepting the prize, the recipient agrees to be featured in an article to appear in university publications in print and/or online.
- (ii) the prize cannot be shared.
