

Clinical Excellence Queensland Midwifery Scholarship 2025

1. Purpose

The Scholarship is to support an undergraduate student facing financial hardship who is studying within the area of midwifery at The University of Queensland.

2. Definitions

In these rules-

Head means the Head of School, Nursing, Midwifery and Social Work.

3. Award and value of scholarship

(1) Six Scholarships may be awarded each year on the recommendation of the Head.

(2) The value of the Scholarship will be \$5000 each student

4. Eligibility for award

An applicant is eligible for the Scholarship, if the applicant –

- (a) can demonstrate financial need;
- (b) is an Australian citizen or permanent resident;
- (c) submits an application to the Head of School, by the closing date for applications; and
- (d) is enrolled in the Bachelor of Midwifery at The University of Queensland.

5. Selection of award

(1) For the selection process, the Head must establish a selection committee, comprising –

- (a) the Head of Discipline, Midwifery;
- (b) Program Lead, Bachelor of Midwifery, or nominee; and
- (c) a selected midwifery academic staff, or nominee.

(2) The Scholarship will be awarded on the basis of the following criteria –

- (a) demonstrated financial need;
- (b) strength of personal statement included with application; and
- (c) any other evidence that may be deemed relevant to the applicant's future success in the field of Midwifery.
