



School of Chemistry and Molecular Biosciences Global Hub of Advanced Materials and Integrated Optoelectronics (AMIO) Chemistry Honours Scholarship

The Honours Scholarship (\$3,000) is directly associated with Global Hub of Advanced Materials and Integrated Optoelectronics (GH-AMIO) project funded by the Department of Industry Science and Resources in partnership with the Australian Academy of Technological Sciences & Engineering (ATSE) and the Australian Academy of Science. This scholarship will be administered in the School of Chemistry and Molecular Biosciences (SCMB), Faculty of Science at The University of Queensland.

1. Purpose

The purpose of the scholarship is to support Honours students to undertake research projects, which focus on the development of organic functional materials like carbon-based semiconductors for optoelectronics under the project principal supervisor of A/Prof Shih-Chun Lo at SCMB.

2. Definitions

In these rules:

Head means the Head of School, SCMB

Approved program means the Bachelor of Science (Honours) or Bachelor of Advanced Science (Honours) or Biotechnology (Honours)

Field of study means the area of research in semiconductor materials for quantum technology and optoelectronics

Scholarship means the GH-AMIO Chemistry Honours Scholarship

The project principal supervisor means A/Prof Shih-Chun Lo.

3. Award and Value of Scholarship

- (1) One scholarship can be awarded on the recommendation of the Head of School in consultation with the selection committee.
- (2) The value of a scholarship is \$3,000.

a. Eligibility for Award

An applicant is eligible for the scholarship, if the applicant:

- (a) submits an application to the Head, by the closing date for applications; and
- (b) will enroll (or is at enrolled at the time of receipt) in the approved Honours program in the relevant field of study.

b. Selection Process

(1) For the selection process, the Head must establish a selection committee, comprising:

- (a) Head or delegate as the Chair of the selection committee
- (b) at least two academics or program directors from SCMB or SMP in the relevant field including the project principal supervisor .

(2) The Scholarship is awarded to the applicant on the basis of:

- (a) Academic excellence
- (b) The strength of their personal statement outlining why the applicant deserves the scholarship
