(The Sum, Wing and Leong Fong Prize in Radiology was established in 2020. Professor Kwun Fong, along with the Fong and Franz families, wishes to honour the memory of UQ alumnus Dr Sum Fong, a radiologist who passed away in 2017. The families also established an endowed prize available to UQ staff. With the creation of this prize the families wish to support academically excellent students who may be interested in pursuing careers in radiology.)

(a) Recommending authority

Head, Northside Clinical Unit, Greater Brisbane Clinical School, Medical School after consultation with a selection committee, comprising –

- (i) the Head, Northside Clinical Unit, Greater Brisbane Clinical School, Medical School (or nominee); and
- (ii) two academic staff members from the Discipline of Radiology.

(b) Eligibility

The prize is available to students who are enrolled in the year 3 or 4 of the Doctor of Medicine program and have completed a clinical rotation in the year of the award.

(c) Basis for award

The prize will be made to reward the student with the highest scoring radiology-related research presentation at an event held by the University of Queensland Radiology Interest Group (UQRIG).

(d) Nature of prize

At least \$1,000, but limited to the annual distribution from the fund.
