



UQ English Language Scholarship (Packaged) – Terms and Conditions

The University of Queensland has partnered with UQ College, to offer an English Language Scholarship.

1. Purpose

The purpose of the Scholarship is to demonstrate the University's commitment to championing diversity, equal opportunity and student success.

2. Definitions

In these terms and conditions –

Applicant means a person who has applied for admission to a UQ program and is being considered for a packaged offer that includes the Approved Program.

Approved Program means the Bridging English Program at UQ College.

Approved Cohort means eligible international students who hold a packaged offer for a UQ coursework program and an approved English language pathway to commence in 2026 or 2027, or another cohort as approved by the University for the Scholarship.

Approved duration means the Bridging English Program duration specified on the scholarship offer.

Packaged offer means an offer for a UQ coursework program that is packaged with an offer to complete the approved program before commencing in the UQ coursework program.

Recipient means a student who has been awarded the UQ English Language Scholarship.

Satisfactory Academic Progress means meeting the requirements to remain enrolled in accordance with the College's Academic Progression Procedure.

Scholarship means the UQ English Language Scholarship for the Approved Cohort.

College means UQ College (UQC).

UQ program means the coursework program of study at The University of Queensland to which the applicant has received an offer to commence in 2027 or 2028.

University means The University of Queensland (UQ).

3. Scholarship, Value and Selection

- (1) As a recipient of this Scholarship, a waiver for the UQC enrolment fee and a 20% discount to the Approved Program tuition fees will be applied.
- (2) The Scholarship will be awarded as a reimbursement post census date of the first intake in the UQ program.
- (3) The Scholarship covers already paid –
 - a. UQC Student Services and Materials Fee.
 - b. Up to 20 weeks of Tuition fees for the approved duration of the Approved Program, as specified in the recipient's Scholarship offer. Any Approved Program tuition fees for study beyond the approved duration are not covered by the Scholarship.
 - i. Any bursary or scholarship previously awarded at UQC will be adjusted on a pro rata basis.
 - ii. Bridging English Extension is not covered.
- (4) The Scholarship will be offered based on meeting the eligibility and scholarship criteria of the UQ program as outlined in section 4(1).
- (5) Receipt of the Scholarship does not preclude a student from being considered for other UQ scholarships prior to commencing their UQ program.
- (6) The University reserves the right to withdraw a Scholarship offer and/or adjust the requirements for Scholarship eligibility and selection timeframe at its discretion.

4. Eligibility and Scholarship Criteria

- (1) An applicant is eligible for the Scholarship, if the applicant –
 - a. is from an Approved Cohort;
 - b. has met the academic requirements for admission to the UQ program, subject to meeting English language proficiency requirements through the Approved Program;
- (2) Scholarship will be awarded as a reimbursement, if the recipient has enrolled into the approved UQ program.



5. Conditions for Scholarship

- (1) An applicant must accept their packaged offer, meet any payment requirements specified in their offer and enrol into the UQ program, for the Scholarship to be confirmed.
- (2) An applicant must satisfy any outstanding conditions of their UQ program offer, including English language proficiency requirements, before commencing their UQ program.
- (3) The Scholarship is offered for the approved commencement date specified in the scholarship offer letter. If a recipient defers or interrupts their study to a future semester, they may no longer be eligible for the Scholarship. Eligibility may be re-assessed by the University for the new commencement semester, if applicable.
- (4) Recipient must maintain satisfactory academic progress at UQC under the [Academic Progress and Support Procedure – ELICOS](#).
- (5) Recipient must maintain full-time enrolment in their UQC and UQ program.
- (6) At the conclusion of the Approved Program, the recipient must meet the English language proficiency and the [UQ College's attendance requirements](#) for admission to their UQ program.

6. Termination of Scholarship

- (1) The University may terminate a Scholarship –
 - a. if the recipient does not enrol in the Approved Program or UQ program in the proposed intake/semester of commencement; or
 - b. if the recipient defers or interrupts their study without approval or abandons their study; or
 - c. does not maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress; or
 - d. if the recipient commits misconduct under the University's Student Integrity and Misconduct Policy; or
 - e. if the recipient otherwise becomes ineligible with respect to section 4.
