



UQ Lifelong Learner (Domestic) – Terms and Conditions

The UQ Lifelong Learner is funded by The University of Queensland (UQ).

1. Purpose

The purpose of the UQ Lifelong Learner Scheme is to recognise and reward UQ alumni returning to UQ to undertake postgraduate coursework studies on a full-fee paying basis.

2. Definitions

In these terms and conditions –

Scheme means the UQ Lifelong Learner for domestic students commencing in 2027.

Fee Reduction means the fee reduction offered through the Scheme.

Relevant program means any postgraduate coursework program at The University of Queensland with the exception of the following programs: Bachelor of Medical Science / Doctor of Medicine, Bachelor of Pharmaceuticals and Therapeutic Science / Doctor of Pharmacy, Doctor of Clinical Dentistry, Doctor of Dental Medicine, Doctor of Medicine, Doctor of Medicine (Ochsner), Doctor of Medicine (Provisional), Graduate Certificate in Business Administration, Graduate Certificate in Sports Coaching, Graduate Certificate in Sports Medicine, Master of Audiology Studies, Master of Business Administration, Master of Business Psychology, Master of Clinical Psychology, Master of Nursing (Graduate Entry), Master of Occupational Therapy Studies, Master of Physiotherapy Studies, Master of Speech Pathology Studies, Master of Sports Coaching, and Master of Sports Medicine.

Relevant Semester means the semester of commencement outlined in the formal notification of eligibility.

Satisfactory Academic Progress means meeting the requirements to remain enrolled in accordance with the University's Academic Progression Procedure.

University means The University of Queensland (UQ).

UQ Alumnus means a student who has completed a program at bachelor level or higher at UQ prior to commencing a relevant program, and in the case of graduates of coursework programs, has completed at least 16 units of study at UQ prior to commencing the relevant program.

3. UQ Lifelong Learner, Value and Selection

- (1) The Scheme is a tuition fee reduction of 20% per annum for the duration of the enrolled coursework program.
- (2) The Scheme will be offered based on meeting the eligibility criteria of the degree in section 4.
- (3) The University reserves the right to withdraw a Scheme offer and/or adjust the requirements for Scheme eligibility and selection timeframe at its discretion.

4. Eligibility and UQ Lifelong Learner Criteria

- (1) An applicant is eligible for the UQ Lifelong Learner, if the applicant –
 - a. is a UQ Alumnus; and
 - b. is a full-fee paying domestic student in accordance with the University's Fee Policy; and
 - c. commences a relevant program at UQ in the relevant semester; and
 - d. does not hold a Commonwealth Supported Place in the relevant program; and
 - e. has not received another scholarship, tuition fee reduction or rebate from UQ; and
 - f. has not received a full scholarship/sponsorship from another organisation (applicants with partial scholarships/sponsorships will be considered at the University's discretion).
- (2) Vertical dual programs –
 - a. UQ students completing their postgraduate study as a portion of a vertical dual program will not be eligible for the Scheme.



5. Selection, Offer and Award of UQ Lifelong Learner

- (1) An applicant will automatically be considered for the Scheme if they meet the eligibility criteria in section 4.
- (2) Applicants will be notified if they have been offered a Fee Reduction under the Scheme at the point of receiving their unconditional offer for their relevant program.

6. Conditions for UQ Lifelong Learner

An applicant must have an unconditional UQ offer.

- (1) The Scheme is offered for the program and commencement semester specified in the program offer letter.
- (2) If a recipient defers their commencement of study to a future semester, they may no longer be eligible for the Scheme. The recipient's eligibility will be re-evaluated for the new commencement semester if applicable.
- (3) If a recipient changes their program, they may no longer be eligible for the Scheme. The recipient's eligibility for the Scheme in the new program will be determined by the list of excluded programs in section 2 (Definitions) under relevant programs.
- (4) Recipients must maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress for the duration of their program.

7. Termination of UQ Lifelong Learner

- (1) The University may terminate a Scheme if the recipient:
 - a. does not enrol in a relevant program in the proposed semester of commencement,
 - b. commits serious misconduct,
 - c. fails to maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress, or
 - d. otherwise becomes ineligible with respect to section 4(1).
